After confirming this information, you will be asked for the meeting password. This is the webinar password, which also can be found in your invitation.

You can then enter the room using the "Join" button.


The webinar will be opened to participants 15 minutes prior to the start time.

## **Agenda**

The press briefing will follow a typical schedule: Opening remarks and introductions, followed by presentations, and then you may ask questions. The press conference will be held in German, but questions in English are permitted.

#### Q&A

- All participants will be muted automatically. You can only switch off the mute setting once it has been removed by the Paul-Ehrlich-Institut.
- If you want to ask a question, please raise your hand virtually (hand symbol at the bottom of the webinar window).
- Your microphone will then be activated by the Paul-Ehrlich-Institut when it is your turn to speak. You must confirm the activation yourself.



We ask that each participant limit themselves to one question to ensure that as many journalists as possible can have a turn.

Please put down your virtually raised hand after speaking.

You can also submit questions in writing during the presentations via the "Questions & Answers" feature.
